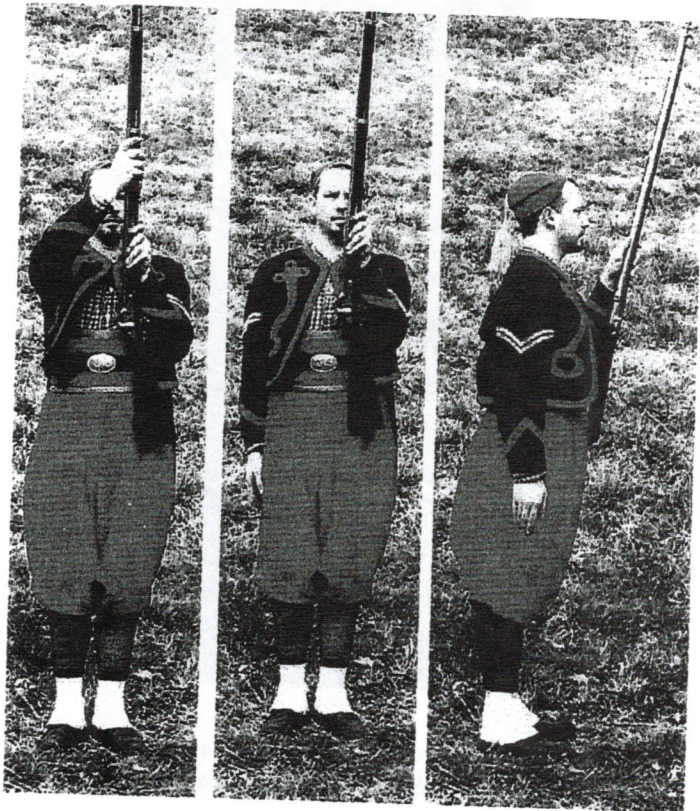

*The company prepared for inspection, the Inspector will now move along the rank(s). Each man to be inspected, when the instructor stands before him will:*

- Quickly raise the piece with **THE RIGHT HAND** before the body, **lock plate to the front**, and grasp the piece **WITH THE LEFT HAND** between the guide sight and lower band<sup>6</sup>.
- The stock should rest against the left forearm; the **left hand should be at the height of the chin**, the piece opposite the left eye,<sup>7</sup> and vertical.



<sup>6</sup> C238H229... Each (recruit), as the instructor reaches him, will raise smartly his piece with his right hand, seize it with the left between the lower band and guide sight, the lock to the front...

<sup>7</sup> C238/H229... left hand at the height of the chin, the piece Opposite to the left eye...
