

Private (later Corporal) Samuel McIlvaine, Oxford, Benton County IN Company D, "Grand Prairie Guards," 10th Indiana Volunteer Infantry Image made 3 May 1862, near Corinth MS, based on an entry in his wartime diary McIlvaine died as the result of a fall while exploring a cave, near Shell Mound TN, on/about 7 September 1863 (official dates vary).

McIlvaine is buried in the Chattanooga National Military Cemetery.



Private Martin V. Wert, Crawfordsville, Montgomery County IN
Mustered in as a Recruit Private, 5 October 1861
Company B, 10th Indiana Volunteer Infantry
Image probably made circa Fall 1861, in Kentucky
(possibly in New Haven or Bardstown)

Wert survived the war (WIA at least twice) and mustered out in November 1864.

M. V. Wert later served briefly, at the age of 54 (!), as Captain of Company M, 2nd Regiment, Indiana National Guard, during the Spanish-American War (1898)

Wert was also elected as Mayor of Crawfordsville IN just prior to World War I.

Martin V. Wert died in 1928, aged 87.
